Two senior clinicians in the field of bovine and small ruminant health management

The National Veterinary School of Alfort (EnvA) is a public institution of higher education and research which trains nearly 850 students divided into six promotions.

The Veterinary Teaching Hospital dedicated to production animals (CHUV-AP) is a clinical platform serving teaching and research missions. The CHUV-AP welcomes students in initial training as well as 2 to 4 interns.

The CHUV-AP manages:

- Consultations and hospitalization of more than 400 production animals (mainly cattle, sheep and goats) accommodated in a new dedicated hospital;
- Herd follow ups, sanitary or prophylactic follow ups;
- Management of clinical cases of these farms;
- Carrying out audits of farms facing herd problems.

The EnvA is currently seeking candidates for two senior clinician positions in the field of **bovine** and small ruminant health management to complete its multidisciplinary team of the CHUV-AP.

Duties

Participate in clinical teaching and service of the CHUV-AP

Develop extra-mural (in farm) services

Develop research activities

Participate to teaching activities: supervise veterinary thesis, tutor veterinary students, supervise residents...

Develop actions of continuing education

Participate to the out of hour duties of the CHUV-AP

Participate to communication activities of the CHUV-AP

Candidates must:

- Hold a Doctorate in Veterinary Medicine, or equivalent;
- Be licensed to practice veterinary medicine in France;
- Be able to communicate in French;
- Have a strong clinical experience;
- Have a strong interest in teaching.
